SCRANTON PREPARATORY SCHOOL ~ COVID PROTOCOL

Last revised: August 11, 2022

Effective immediately, we will be following the protocols below:

- Those who are sick should stay home;
- Those who test positive for Covid:
 - Should contact our nurse, Mrs. Zeleniak, by emailing her at <u>nurse@scrantonprep.org</u> or by calling the school.
 - Will need to isolate for a minimum of five (5) days from the first day of symptoms or the day of the positive test result, whichever comes first;
 - Should call Mrs. Zeleniak on day 5;
 - May return on or after day 6 as long as their symptoms are improving, and they been fever-free for at least 24 hours without taking fever reducing medication;
 - Should inform close contacts (anyone who was inside of a 6-foot radius of the positive individual for 15 or more cumulative minutes over a 24 hour period)
- Prep will no longer contact trace; instead, Prep will post case updates to its webpage;
- Those identified as close contacts should mask for ten (10) days from the last exposure to the positive individual; symptomatic close contacts should take a Covid home test and report their results to Mrs. Zeleniak;
- Masking will not be required of the general student, faculty, and staff community; everyone is expected to support those who wish to mask;
- As always, if we feel that there is sufficient cause, the school reserves the right to adjust its mitigation measures.
